RESIDENT ARTIST REQUIREMENTS

- Each resident artist will be assigned a 5–7 foot wide x 8 foot tall wall by the board to hang their work. Artists will hang their own displays within the allotted area.
- Resident artists must display a framed artist bio/ statement.
- Artists are welcome to exchange artwork in their display at any time, and replace pieces that have sold. Any changes must be documented on the artist inventory form in the exhibit binder.
- 2-dimensional pieces must be clean, securely framed, wired (no sawtooth hooks), and ready to hang.
- Framed original paintings, photography, mixed media, and framed original prints such as etchings are welcome. **Reproduction prints of original artwork are not permitted.**
- All work submitted must be the ORIGINAL work of the artist. Work based on published photographs or other artists' work, or work produced in classes, workshops, or under the direct supervision of an instructor should not be submitted.
- Resident artists may display their work for a maximum of 2 back-to-back shows (6 months) before being put on a waitlist for the next available space.
- *MWVAA reserves the right not to display works deemed inappropriate.*

SHOP ITEMS

Resident artists may have a print or card rack in front of their display, with no limit on the number of prints. Each shop item must be labeled with **1)** your initials, **2)** the price, **3)** the type of item, inventory # or code

COMMISSIONS AND GALLERY SITTING

All participating artists are expected to gallery sit once per month for the duration of the exhibit. Artists must sign up for shifts upon dropping off artwork. If you are unable to fulfill sitting responsibilities, you will be subject to a higher fee/commission rate to help the association cover your shifts.
